NLI Associate, Kola Oyeneyin, makes History with Generational Voices

Kola Oyeneyin, NLI Associate and CEO of Venia Group made history in January 2014 when he convened the highly impactful 100,000 Voices Telethon called Generational Voices (GenVoices). GenVoices was conceived as a project driven platform to harness the energy of young Nigerians for nation building. With an endorsement from the United Nations, the event which was broadcast to over 25 million viewers and listeners across Nigeria, 22 African countries and numerous locations across the globe. Many NLI Associates played critical roles in the success of the highly inspirational event. NLI Governing Board Chairman, Dr. Christopher Kolade, delivered a motivational charge to young Nigerians at the event: *"you can't expect me to transform this nation. I have no need for transformation. The power of transformation is vested in your palms and (you) the young people are the generation of transformation"* We say kudos to Kola for moving from *"success to significance."*





NLI Safer Skies Portal to be launched on June 3

Under NLI's Safer Skies Initiative, the October 2013 Associates Class has now completed the Safer Skies Portal which is scheduled for public launch on June 3, 2014. The launch date is to coincide with a solidarity to and sympathy with the families of the victims of the Dana air accident of June 3, 2012. When operational, the Safer Skies Portal will allow air travellers to report safety issues and observations. It will also offer air operators a platform to provide information and/or clarifications on reported issues. Air regulators will also be able to monitor reported incidences and take necessary action.

NLI contributes to UK Parliamentary Report on Democracy and Development in Africa

NLI recently contributed to a study by UK Parliamentarians study on what democracy in Africa looks like, what it means for development, and the role the international community plays to shape democracy and development in Africa. Under the aegis of The Africa All Party Parliamentary Group (APPG), with the valuable assistance of NLI Senior Fellows (Dr. Titi Banjoko and Professor Oba Nsugbe) as well as NLI Associates (Mssrs. Tolu Ogunlesi and Reginald Bassey), NLI submitted a report which was well acclaimed by the APPG. The report further highlights the role of NLI in promoting a regime of accountability, transparency and responsibility in governance in Nigeria.
